After college, her determination to make her own way in life led to works in publishing and media-related fields. She won the Greek Onassis Award for her play Harvest. An award-winning film *Deham* was made by Govind Nihalani based on the play. She has written one more powerful play, *Lights Out!* (1984), *Hidden Fires* is a series of monologues. *The Artist's Model* (1995) and *Sextet* are her other works.(1996). She has also authored a collection of short stories, called *Kleptomania*. Her most recent book, published in 2008, is *Escape*. Apart from writing newspaper columns she created comic strips. She created Suki, an Indian comic character, which was serialized as a strip in the *Sunday Observer*. Before 1997 (the year her play Harvest was staged) she was better known as a cartoonist
