Methyl bromide (MeBr), used as a fumigant to control several soil-borne pests in various crops, is a strong ozone depleter, and governments and international agencies aware of the problem have agreed to establish a programme to phase out its use. As a result, some literature on new MeBr alternatives is available that describes the feasibility and disadvantages of each new pest control measure. Some of these publications result from workshops and symposia organized in different countries by the United Nations Environment Programme and by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization. The present report provides information on successful alternatives in some countries or regions where MeBr is being phased out. This report assesses the Ministry of Defence's performance in managing the supply chain to front line troops. The MoD rightly puts a strong emphasis on ensuring troops get the supplies they need. Equally, providing an efficient supply chain would release resources for the front line. The Committee believes there should be greater emphasis on securing value for money and that there is room for it to find efficiencies in the supply chain without jeopardising operational effectiveness. Previous reports have identified persistent problems with late deliveries, unnecessary costs and missed targets. At present, the MoD does not have the information to identify where savings could be made. It does not know the full costs of its current activities or the cost of alternative supply options. The failure to collect basic data about where supplies are stored has

directly contributed to the MoD accounts being qualified for three consecutive years. The MoD is now seeking to resolve these information problems through a major initiative known as the Future Logistics Information Services project, expected to be implemented by 2014. Until then, the Department will continue to store data in systems that are at critical risk of failure. It is vital that the MOD sustains its programme in order to secure value for money. Measures which could improve the efficiency of supply operations include putting more pressure on suppliers to deliver on time, keeping stocks at lower levels to reduce the risk of them deteriorating, and benchmarking performance against relevant comparators such as other armed forces.

In 2019, 13 national competent authorities (NCAs) -- the same number as in 2018 -- granted limitations (under Article 35(6) of the Solvency II Directive) to 838 solo undertakings for first-quarterly reporting in 2019 (compared with 791 solo undertakings in the first quarter of 2018 -- Q1 2018). Five NCAs (five in 2017) granted limitations and exemptions from reporting using item-by-item templates (under Article 35(7)) to 136 solo undertakings for annual reporting in 2018 (139 in 2017). Five NCAs (three in 2018) granted limitations for quarterly reporting to 37

groups in Q1 2019 (33 in Q1 2018). Two NCAs (three in 2017) granted limitations and exemptions from reporting on an item-by-item basis for annual reporting to six groups in 2018 (seven groups in 2017). The limitations and exemptions set out in Article 35 of the Solvency II Directive are a concrete proportionality measure in reporting requirements, but should not be seen as the only proportionality measure. To evidence how proportionality is implemented in quarterly reporting, reflecting the nature, scale and complexity of the risks inherent to the business, this report uses two examples: look-through reporting of collective investment undertakings (CIUs) for unit-linked contracts and the number of templates reported by companies of different sizes. EIOPA chose two examples that are different from the examples used in last year's report, to continue to evidence how the proportionality principle is embedded in the Solvency II reporting framework. The examples in last year's report, if applied to 2018 and Q1 2019, would provide similar results to those presented in last year's report. The look-through is reported quarterly for 78% of the investments in CIUs held in unit-linked contracts. In Q1 2019, only 57% of insurance undertakings that held CIUs in unit-linked contracts had to report using the look-through template.¹ In other words, 43% of undertakings that hold CIUs in unit-linked contracts do not have to carry out look-through reporting quarterly and these undertakings have 22% of investments in CIUs in unit-linked contracts.
